#### Sailor Quarterly Report (Stuart Ragland)

- Summary info through March 2016
- An irregularity in the number of EBSCO downloads has been noted. The total number of EBSCO downloads for Maryland Public libraries in the First Quarter was 58,920. In the Second Quarter, that number jumped to 491,946.

Collection Management at the Pratt Library contacted EBSCO to investigate and learned that the huge increase was a result of a huge increase in Science Reference Center downloads for Frederick County Public Library.

A similar situation occurred in 2012-2013 when a huge increase in MasterFile Premier downloads was accrued by the Southern Maryland public libraries. The reason for the increase was traced to the manner in which EBSCO responded to federated search queries originating from the Southern Maryland implementation of Sirsi Enterprise. The increase in Frederick CPL downloads is also associated with a federated search requests going to EBSCO. Jennifer Falkowski, Information Services Manager at Southern Maryland Regional Library, who worked with EBSCO to resolve the Southern Maryland situation, has shared information she received from EBSCO with Frederick CPL to help them understand their situation and work with EBSCO to resolve it.

#### **MDLIBTECH (Stuart Ragland)**

 March 1<sup>st</sup> meeting at Anne Arundel County Public Library. Focus of discussion was communication, expanding group, use of SLACK virtual meeting place as the common platform.



#### **SAILOR Network (Mike Walsh)**

- Comcast is winner of contract for wide area network service for most counties.
- Saint Mary's, Howard and Anne Arundel counties have yet to complete the SLD profile for E-rate funding.
- Talbot County Public Schools are interested in increasing their band width and will reimburse Sailor for the added capacity that they need.

#### Relais/MARINA Update (Emma Beaven)

- The MILO Unit is currently split between two buildings. There are 5 full time staff and one part time staff member at Central and 2 full time and 3 part time staff at the Annapolis Road (ARLOC) location. Because the transshipping unit is now in another location, delivery to other libraries takes an additional day, however we continue to try to maintain our 24 hour turnaround time.
- Marina lending has increased significantly since last year. In FY 2015, Marina lending total was 299,267. As of March 31, 2016, the total is 271,299. The total amount of materials sorted in transshipping as of that date are as follows: In total: 595,167 Out Total: 471,638

## Collections and Access Services Division and SLRC Update (Wendy Allen submitted in writing)

• SLRC Renovation Update:

The Roving Reference Plan is in full operation and has started with department managers first. This will expand to the entire SLRC staff as the Library begins

Proposed Phasing Plan for Cross-Training, Expansion of Roving Reference, and Global Scheduling of Service Points during and post Renovation has been established.

- Digital Maryland Oral History Workshop was held on April 20, 2016.
- Storytelling Conference will be held on June 14, 2016, and this new conference is now in the planned registration is on slrc.info.



- Sailor Databases-the new EBSCO databases are up and running (Small Engine Repair, Hobbies and Crafts and Home Improvement) and the links were sent to county library systems in late February. The link to EBSCO discovery service was also sent in March. Libraries can place the single search box on their own web sites to search all the SAILOR resources from a single interface. The contract for Heritage Quest Online was also finalized in January and ProQuest is currently testing IP access with two Maryland school systems.
- A draft annual plan for FY17 was presented to the SLRC commission and will be voted on for approval in May. A group is being formed to plan for the next SLRC strategic plan. The group includes Dennis Nangle, Daria Parry, Debby Bennett, Wesley Wilson and Wendy Allen.

#### **SLRC Financial Report (Mike Walsh)**

- Sailor database renewals will have no significant impact on the current fiscal year budget.
- Regional Information Center vacancy and slowdown in hiring process via Baltimore City has resulted in lower expenditures to date.
- In FY 17 we see a 2% increase in SLRC budget from 9.9 million to 10.2 Million, so we will be able give a 5% increase to Baltimore County and Montgomery County delivery partners. The directors have been notified of the increase.
